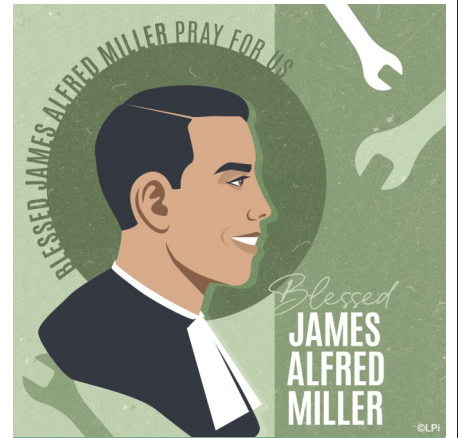

CHILD PROTECTION AND CREATING SAFE ENVIRONMENTS

Bystanders can help. Bystanders can play a big role in stopping bullying. When people do nothing, it sends a message that it's no big deal to bully. If people say something, it sends a social message that bullying is not OK. If you see someone being bullied, you can help by doing these things: *Speak up to help:* If it feels safe and natural to speak up, say, "come on, let's get out of here" to the person being bullied. It is okay to let the bully know people are watching and will get involved. *Report it:* Let a trusted adult know what you witnessed. This isn't tattling, it is standing up for what's right. *Offer support:* Check in with the person who was being bullied. Ask how they are doing. Remind them that the bullying is not their fault.
