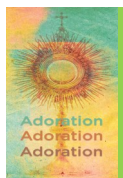

EUCCHARISTIC REVIVAL ART CONTEST 2023

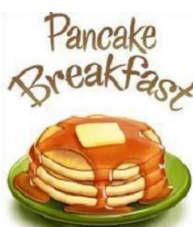
Students in grades K-12: here is an opportunity for you to shine!
